

Report on Training workshop on the increasing awareness of personnel from environmental protection organizations and other interested persons on POPs/PTS which held in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia

The workshop was organized on 4th of October, 2013 at the Fresh water resource and nature conservation center in Ulaanbaatar. The conference hall with other required equipments was provided by the Ministry of Environment and Green Development of Mongolia.

Dr. Marina Klimova and Dr. Lyudmila Lyashenko from Russian Centre for International Projects are presented 3 lectures ("Environmentally sound management of chemicals. Background, development and nowadays problem", "Negative effects of POPs on human health and environment", "Persistent organic pollutants"). Lectures were provided by oral translation from Russian into Mongolian. From Mongolian side prepared 3 presentations prepared by Dr. Jargalsaikhan ("Measures taken in Mongolia for implementation of Stockholm Convention"), National coordinator of Baikal project Mrs. S.Tumurchudur ("About Integrated Natural Resource Management of in Baikal Basin Transboundary Ecosystem") and researcher D.Otgonsuren ("Results of gas chromatographic analysis of PCB in transformer oil". We did 46 invitation calls for personnel from governmental environment protection, agriculture organizations as well as from research institutes. 36 participants took part in workshop including 6 persons from 4 provinces (Khubsugul - 2, Selenge - 2, Darkhanuul – 1, Orkhon – 1) involving to Baikal Basin. We did translation from Russian to Mongolian the POPs/PTS training brochure containing 54 pages A4 (around 45 lines, 347 words on one page). Adopted Mongolian translation includes 51 pages A4 (around 39 lines, 335 words on one page). Also we added one part about implementation of provisions of Stockholm Convention POPs in Mongolia. In the result we published 100 copies of training brochure (A5 format, 79 pages) in Mongolian for participants of training workshop and other interested persons.



All participants were provided with notebooks, pens and folder case.

The workshop lasted from 9:30 to 16:30. During the workshop were organized 3 breaks: 2 for coffee and lunch.
