FINAL REPORT

1. Introduction

IWRM plans for both the Khuvsgul lake-Eg and Ider river basins have been developed for the period 1 October 2012 to 28 February 2014.

The plans have been endorsed on 12 June 2014 by the Environment and Green Development Minister's order No A-228.

2. Motivation

The results of the questionnaire conducted during preparation of the IWRM plan shows that more than 90 per cent of the responders have no knowledge about IWRM. Moreover, the Ider River Basin Administration was established only in May 2014 the Khuvsgul lake-Eg River Basin Administration in September 2013. Staff of the administrations are just university graduates.

Thus quite number of activities under the "Strategic objective 1": Strengthening the implementation capacity of the IWRM plan and capacity of all organization involved in IWRM of both IWRM plans devoted to conduct various trainings.

3. Objective and workplan

The objective of the training was to build capacity of

• the river basins' administration and





- the government and non government officials at soums and
- to implement some of the training activities planned in the IWRM plans of both river basins.

4. Training material

For the training, the handbook "Catalyzing Change: A handbook for developing integrated water resources management (IWRM) and water efficiency strategies" was used.

Using the above handbook, 5 modules have been prepared. The training was not one side event i.e. just giving some lecture to participants. For the motivation of the participants each supported by an exercise. Thus exercise developed as case study of the Ider and Khuvsgul lake – Eg river basins. The presentations of the training is attached.
